- Quizizz is a game-based learning platform in which you can create and host interactive lessons and quizzes for synchronous and asynchronous learning.
- Quizizz features:
  - Access to millions of Quizzes
  - Instructor paced lessons/Quizzes
  - Student paced lessons/Quizzes
  - Reports: Detailed class-level and student-level insights for every quiz.
  - Options to Customize

## Free Account

- Choose from over 30 million of teacher-created quizzes and lessons
- Create quizzes with 4 different type of questions
- Create instructor-paced lessons
- Host a live quiz in a class or via video conferencing
- Assign student-paced quizzes that learners play on their personal devices at class or at home
- Up to 100 students per quiz/assignment
- Team mode – Lets players join teams from personal or shared devices and compete against other teams
